

Professional Accreditation

The aim of accreditation is to provide professional qualifications in meteorology which will satisfy clients, employers and the public at large that individuals have reached and continue to maintain a specified level of professional knowledge and experience and that they adhere to a declared code of professional conduct. Accreditation provides a link and standards across the wider meteorological community. It benefits individuals by providing recognition of their role and skills; a framework to support career development; and provides a demonstration of commitment to their career.

The Society offers two professional accreditation schemes:

- **Chartered Meteorologist** ^[1]
- **Registered Meteorologist** ^[2]

These schemes are hierarchical statements of professional competency and experience and are consistent in concept and scope with similar accreditations recognised in other professions.

Accreditation provides a link and standards across the wider meteorological community. The Royal Meteorological Society is the only body able to award Registered or Chartered status for Meteorologists. The Society does not provide any guarantee of the quality of individual work by accredited meteorologists. Those who provide professional services on their own behalf to third parties are responsible for their own work and professional indemnity cover.

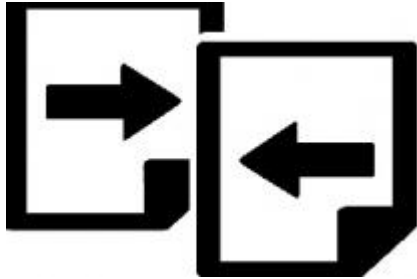
